

FBS Student Dress Code Kindergarten- Fifth Grade 2017-2018

The goal of First Baptist School Student Dress Code is to honor God in our outward appearance. The dress code seeks to maintain an atmosphere of equality and promotes school pride. It is difficult for a dress code to be entirely comprehensive, therefore, FBS retains the right to determine the appropriateness of every student's dress and amend the dress code as deemed necessary. FBS requires all families to comply with the uniform code. As a general interpretation, if an item is not addressed in the FBS dress code, it is not appropriate to wear to school. **The administration has the final authority in interpreting student dress code policies.**

All monogramed items (shirts, jumpers, jackets) must be purchased and stitched at Prints Charming, 5301 Everhart, CC, TX, 855-7777

If you have any question as to whether your child's attire meets FBS standardized dress code, please feel free to call or stop by the office for approval.

Shirt Guidelines: All Students	
Style	"Polo" pique shirt with FBS logo on left side for Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Oxford button down blouse/shirt with FBS logo on left side for Wednesday Chapel Day . Short or Long sleeves are allowed.
Color	Polo: Hunter Green – PIQUE fabric only, NOT nylon Oxford: White button down blouse/shirt for Wednesday Chapel Day .
Fit	Shirts should not be too tight, oversized or excessively long. Length: must be 4 inches below the belt line and tucked in at all times. Only solid white undershirts with no print may be worn under the uniform shirt.
Other	All FBS school t-shirts are permitted on Fridays ONLY. For cold weather, undershirts must have SOLID white or hunter green long sleeves. Undershirts may not extend past the uniform shirt length.

Pants : Boys	Pants/Capri Pants: Girls	Guidelines
Style	Standard, uniform type, two pocket pants.	
Color	Khaki pants Dark Standard Denim jeans/capris may be worn on Fridays ONLY .	
Fit	Properly fitted at the waist, crotch, legs, and ankles. Not baggy, saggy or too tight pants. No leggings worn as pants or low rise pants.	
Other	Neatly hemmed. NO designs or embellishments down the legs. (Pocket design ok on jeans) Pants must be belted at all times with a solid, plain, black or brown belt.	
Restrictions	No skinny pants. <u>No torn pants or pants with holes</u> or pants with frayed hems. No distressed jeans/pants. Normal wear and fading is okay.	

Shorts: Boys & Girls	Skirts/Jumper: Girls	Guidelines
Style	Standard, uniform type, 2 pocket walking shorts. Standard, uniform type, skirt or jumper (Jumper must have FBS Logo on left side).	
Color	Khaki Dark Standard Denim shorts or skirts may be worn on Fridays ONLY .	
Fit	ALL Walking shorts, skirts, and jumpers must not be more than 2 inches above the knee (the width of a dollar bill). Properly fitted at the waist, crotch, and be modest in appearance. Not baggy, saggy or too tight, and not low rise.	
Other	Modesty shorts must be worn under skirts and jumpers. In the event of cold weather, only solid white tights or knee socks are permitted . Jumper is to have FBS logo on left side.	
Wednesday Chapel	Girls are to wear Khaki skirt or jumper with white oxford button down blouse. Boys are to wear Khaki pants with white oxford button down shirt.	

Shoes/Socks Guidelines: All Students	
Style	Athletic shoes are required for safety reasons as all students will participate in PE activities. Socks must be worn with athletic shoes. On Wednesday Chapel Day , students will have health class and may opt to wear flats (slip-ons, ballet type, etc.) or boots. Shoes must be closed-toe/closed-heel.
Color	Any color for shoes. Socks must be white, black, or brown. In the event of cold weather, only solid white tights or knee socks are permitted.
Fit	All shoes must be properly laced, all straps properly secured.
Other	Boots and other non-athletic type flats are only permitted on Wednesday Chapel Day.
Restrictions	Not allowed: Open toe shoes, Open heel shoes, Platform shoes, Heels, Flip-flops, Slaps, Heelys/Grinders, Crocs, or Sandals.

Sweatshirts/Jackets/Sweaters Guidelines: All Students	
Style	School designated from Prints Charming...5301 Everhart...855-7777 Windbreaker Jacket/ Full-zip Sweatshirt Jacket/Cardigan Sweater (All with FBS logo)
Color	Full-zip Sweatshirt Jacket -heather gray or hunter green (with FBS LOGO) Nylon Windbreaker Fleece-lined Jacket-hunter green (from Prints Charming) Cardigan Sweater-white or hunter green (may be purchased elsewhere and stitched at Prints Charming)
Fit	Properly fitted. Not baggy, saggy or too tight.
Other	Other jackets allowed OUTSIDE ONLY for extreme cold. FBS jackets must be worn inside.

Hair Style/Jewelry Guidelines: All Students	
Color	Natural color.
Cut	Neat and properly groomed. No Mohawk cuts or design cuts; No spiky styles.
Girls	Hair is to be clean and may not distract from or interfere with the learning and school environment (i.e.: bangs may not hang in eyes). Hair bows/headbands/accessories must be only: green, gold, yellow, or white.
Boys	Hair is to be clean and may not distract/interfere with learning and school environment. Hair may not be bushy and must be above the eyebrow, it may be no longer than the top of the ear and must be above the top of a polo-style collared shirt.
Jewelry	Noisy, distracting, and excessive jewelry or accessories are not allowed. Girls may wear pierced earrings, but no more than two earrings per ear. Girls' earrings may not extend below the earlobes. No dangling earrings are allowed, due to safety. Boys are not allowed to wear earrings. All other body piercing jewelry is not allowed.

Consequences

We ask all parents to help their student comply with the FBS student dress code. Students who are not in code lose valuable instructional time and take teacher, school staff, and parents away from their duties and responsibilities. The following steps will be taken to address dress code infractions:

1. Teachers will document violation of dress code on the student's behavior chart for each violation.
2. Students who are in violation of dress code guidelines will call parents to bring a change of clothes.
3. Habitual dress code offenders will be referred to the principal. Parents will be called for a conference.
